of people from Allah is the harsh-hearted."



The Prophet said, "Do you say a lack of possessions is poverty?" I said yes. The Prophet repeated this three times, then he said, "Wealth is in the heart and poverty is in the heart. Whoever is wealthy in his heart will not be harmed no matter what happens in the world. Whoever is impoverished in his heart will not be satisfied no matter how much he has in the world. Verily, he will only be harmed by the greed of his own soul."

Ibn Abbas reported: The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, would supplicate by saying, "O Lord, help me and do not help against me, support me and do not support against me, plan for me and do not plan against me. O Lord, make me grateful to you, mindful of you, fearful of you, obedient to you, humble to you, turning to you and repenting. O Lord, accept my repentance, wash away my sin, answer my supplication, establish my proof, direct my tongue, guide my heart, and remove the hatred from my chest."






They said, "Of course!" The Prophet said:
