# **About this booklet:**

The purpose of this activity is to enable to participants mention these ahadith in their khutbat and speeches and also encourage them for further memorization.

Before we begin, let us mention two of the beautiful narrations of our beloved Prophet Muhammad ## regarding the virtues of memorizing and communicating forward the ahadith.

At-Tirmidhi (2658) narrated from 'Abdullah ibn Mas'ood that the Prophet said: "May Allah beautify a man who hears a saying of mine, so he understands it, remembers it and conveys it. There may be one who conveys knowledge to someone who understands it better than he does."

Classed as saheeh by al-Albaani in Saheeh al-Jaami' (2309).

Al-Bazzaar (3416) narrated from Muhammad ibn Jubayr ibn Mut'im, from his father (may Allah be pleased with him), from the Prophet that he said: "May Allah beautify a man who hears a saying of mine, so he memorises it and conveys it as he heard it."

May Allah enable us to internalize, implement and communicate forward what we learn from this booklet.

### Hadith 6:

On the authority of Abu Dharr Jundub ibn Junadah, and Abu Abdur-Rahman Muadh bin Jabal (may Allah be pleased with him), that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: Have taqwa (fear) of Allah wherever you may be, and follow up a bad deed with a good deed which will wipe it out, and behave well towards the people.

The Messenger of Allah (\*) said, "There is never any obscenity [Fuhush] in a thing, but it mars it, and there is never any modesty [haya] in a thing, but it adorns it." Sunan Ibn Majah, Book 37, Hadith 4325

The Messenger of Allah (\*\*) said, "Ask Allah for beneficial knowledge and seek refuge with Allah from knowledge that is of no benefit." - Sunan Ibn Majah 3843

# Hadith 11:

The Messenger of Allah (\*) said, "The one who loves for Allah's sake, hates for Allah's sake, gives for Allah's sake and withholds for Allah's sake, will have perfect faith." - Sunan Abi Dawud 4681

### Hadith 12:

The Messenger of Allah (\*) said, "A single endeavor in Allah's cause in the morning or in the evening is better than the world and whatever is in it." Sahih al-Bukhari 2792

The Messenger of Allah (\*) said, "Whoever builds a Masjid for (the sake of) Allah, then Allah will build a similar house for him in Paradise." - Jami` at-Tirmidhi 318

The Prophet(\*) said:

The best of you are those whose shoulders are soft in prayer. - Sunan Abi Dawud 672


# Hadith 22:

The Prophet(\*\*) said: He who has in his heart the weight of even a mustard seed of pride shall not enter Paradise. - Sahih, Book 1, Hadith 173

#### Hadith 23:

The Prophet(\*\*) said: The best of the deeds (or deed) is the (observance of) prayer at its proper time and kindness to the parents. - Sahih Muslim, Book 1, Hadith 162

## Hadith 24:



The Prophet(\*\*) said: "May Allah's mercy be on him who is lenient in his buying, selling, and in demanding back his money." - Sahih al-Bukhari 2076

### Hadith 25:

The Prophet(\*\*) said: "One prayer in my Mosque is better than one thousand prayers in any other mosque excepting Al-Masjid-Al-Haram." – Sunan Ibn Majah, Book 5, Hadith 1470

the Messenger of Allah (s.a.w) said: "Allah's Hand is with the Jama'ah." - Jami` at-Tirmidhi 2166

#### Hadith 27:

### Hadith 28:

The Messenger of Allah (\*\*) said, "When a man dies, his deeds come to an end except for three things: Sadaqah Jariyah (ceaseless charity); a knowledge which is beneficial, or a virtuous descendant

who prays for him (for the deceased)." Sahih Muslim Book 13 - Hadith 4005

# Hadith 29:

The Prophet (\*\*) ordered the people to pay Zakat-ul-Fitr before going to the `ld prayer. - Sahih al-Bukhari 1509

### Hadith 30:

A man said: 'O Messenger of Allah, which kind of charity is best? He said: 'Giving charity when you are in good health, and feeling stingy, hoping for a long life and fearing poverty. - Sunan an-Nasa'i 2542

# Hadith 31:

On the authority of Abdullah, the son of Umar ibn al-Khattab (ra), who said: I heard the Messenger of Allah (\*) say, "Islam has been built on five [pillars]: testifying that there is no deity worthy of worship except Allah and that Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, establishing the salah (prayer), paying the zakat (obligatory charity), making the hajj (pilgrimage) to the House, and fasting in Ramadhan." (Hadith An-Nawawi 3)

It is narrated on the authority of Amirul Mu'minin, Abu Hafs 'Umar bin al-Khattab (ra) who said: I heard the Messenger of Allah (\*) say: "Actions are (judged) by motives (niyyah), so each man will have what he intended. Thus, he whose migration (hijrah) was to Allah and His Messenger, his migration is to Allah and His Messenger; but he whose migration was for some worldly thing he might gain, or for a wife he might marry, his migration is to that for which he migrated." (Hadith An-Nawawi 1)

# Hadith 33:

"He who does an act which we have not commanded, will have it rejected (by Allah)." (Hadith An-Nawawi 5)

On the authority of an-Nu'man ibn Basheer (ra), who said: I heard the Messenger of Allah (\*) say, "That which is lawful is clear and that which is unlawful is clear, and between the two of them are

doubtful matters about which many people do not know. Thus he who avoids doubtful matters clears himself in regard to his religion and his honor, but he who falls into doubtful matters [eventually] falls into that which is unlawful, like the shepherd who pastures around a sanctuary, all but grazing therein. Truly every king has a sanctuary, and truly Allah's sanctuary is His prohibitions. Truly in the body there is a morsel of flesh, which, if it be whole, all the body is whole, and which, if it is diseased, all of [the body] is diseased. Truly, it is the heart." (Hadith An-Nawawi 6)

# Hadith 35:

On the authority of Tameem ibn Aus ad-Daree (ra): The Prophet (\*\*) said, "The deen (religion) is naseehah (advice, sincerity)." We said, "To whom?" He (\*\*) said, "To Allah, His Book, His Messenger, and to the leaders of the Muslims and their common folk." (Hadith An-Nawawi 7)

# Hadith 36:

On the authority of Anas (may Allah be pleased with him) who said:

I heard the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) say, "Allah the Almighty has said: 'O Son of Adam, as long as you invoke Me and ask of Me, I shall forgive you for what you have done, and I shall not mind. O Son of Adam, were your sins

to reach the clouds of the sky and you then asked forgiveness from Me, I would forgive you. O Son of Adam, were you to come to Me with sins nearly as great as the Earth, and were you then to face Me, ascribing no partner to Me, I would bring you forgiveness nearly as great as it [too].' "It was related by at-Tirmidhi, who said that it was a hasan hadeeth. (Hadith An-Nawawi 42)

### Hadith 37:

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said, "None of you [truly] believes until his desires are subservient to that which I have brought." (Hadith An-Nawawi 41)

# Hadith 38:

On the authority of Abdullah ibn Umar (may Allah be pleased with him), who said: The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) took me by the shoulder and said, "Be in this world as though you were a stranger or a wayfarer." And Ibn Umar (may Allah be pleased with him) used to say, "In the evening do not expect [to live until] the morning, and in the morning do not expect [to live until] the evening. Take [advantage of] your health before times of sickness, and [take advantage of] your life before your death." (Hadith An-Nawawi 40)

#### Hadith 39:

On the authority of Ibn Abbas (may Allah be pleased with him), that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said:

Verily Allah has pardoned [or been lenient with] for me my ummah: their mistakes, their forgetfulness, and that which they have been forced to do under duress. (Hadith An-Nawawi 39)

# Hadith 40:

On the authority of Abu Sa`eed al-Khudree (may Allah be pleased with him) who said: I heard the Messenger of Allah (\*) say, "Whosoever of you sees an evil, let him change it with his hand; and if he is not able to do so, then [let him change it] with his tongue; and if he is not able to do so, then with his heart — and that is the weakest of faith." (Hadith An-Nawawi 34)

#### Hadith 41:

On the authority of Abu Sa'eed al-Khudree (may Allah be pleased with him), that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: There should be neither harming (darar) nor reciprocating harm (dirar). (Hadith An-Nawawi 32)

### Hadith 42:

عَنْ أَبِي عَمْرٍ وَقِيلَ : أَبِي عَمْرَةَ سُفْيَانَ بْنِ عَبْدِ اللَّهِ رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: قُلْت : يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ !قُلْ لِي فِي اللهُ عَنْهُ أَحَدًا غَيْرِك ؛ قَالَ : قُلْ : آمَنْت بِاللَّهِ ثُمُّ اسْتَقِمْ الْإِسْلَامِ قَوْلًا لَا أَسْأَلُ عَنْهُ أَحَدًا غَيْرِك ؛ قَالَ : قُلْ : آمَنْت بِاللَّهِ ثُمُّ اسْتَقِمْ

On the authority of Abu `Amr — and he is also called Abu `Amrah — Sufyan bin Abdullah ath- Thaqafee (may Allah be pleased with him) who said:

I said, "O Messenger of Allah, tell me something about al-Islam which I can ask of no one but you." He (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said, "Say I believe in Allah — and then be steadfast." (Hadith An-Nawawi 21)
